Letter from the Program Co-Chairs

In 2014, Henry Schein Cares, the global corporate social responsibility program of Henry Schein, Inc., and Alpha Omega International Dental Fraternity, were very proud to answer the White House's call to action to help Holocaust survivors age with dignity and support. Many of the Holocaust survivors in the United States live in poverty, making it all but impossible to access the care and support services they so desperately need, including dental care.

In response to this critical need, Henry Schein and the Alpha Omega International Dental Fraternity saw a special opportunity to catalyze an innovative public-private partnership to improve the quality of life for this vulnerable population. The result was the formation and launch of the Alpha Omega-Henry Schein Cares Holocaust Survivors Oral Health Program.

The Alpha Omega-Henry Schein Cares Holocaust Survivors Oral Health Program is guided by our two organizations' shared commitment and deep sense of passion to serve those in need. Henry Schein Cares "helps health happen" by expanding access to care for at-risk and underserved populations globally. Since its founding 15 years ago, the model of success for Henry Schein Cares has been the establishment of innovative public-private partnerships, and we have used our experience with that model to drive this impactful oral health program.

Alpha Omega, as an international Jewish dental organization, has a deep commitment to "repairing the world"—the concept of tikkun olam—and in this spirit, the fraternity's Global Oral Health Initiative has been providing for at-risk populations worldwide for decades. With Alpha Omega's unique perspective and special connection with the Holocaust survivor community, the organization recognized the need to improve the oral health and quality of life of this most deserving population and are extremely pleased to provide such essential care through this unique program.

We are truly honored to partner with one another and with many other outstanding people and entities, without whom this initiative would not be possible, including: Vice President Joseph Biden, the White House, the Association of Jewish Family & Children's Agencies, Town & Country Dental Studios, Bedford Health Care Solutions, and our many generous donors. We would like to single out The Claire Friedlander Family Foundation, and its president Peter Klein, for its leadership gift in support of this program.

We thank our partners not only for their compassion, but also for their willingness to stand up and take action on behalf of those who need it most. Program Overview

Alpha Omega International Dental Fraternity and Henry Schein, Inc. created the Alpha Omega-Henry Schein Cares Holocaust Survivors Oral Health Program in response to the White House's call to action to develop innovative public-private partnerships to improve the quality of life of Holocaust survivors. By increasing Holocaust survivors' access to oral care, the program seeks to significantly enhance their overall health and quality of life.

Maintaining good oral health is important for many reasons, including a sense of well-being, self-esteem, and the ability to chew and digest food properly. Poor oral health has also been linked to numerous chronic conditions, including diabetes, respiratory illnesses, and heart disease. Holocaust survivors are particularly at risk because many experienced prolonged nutritional deprivation and received little or no dental care throughout their childhoods, compromising their lifelong oral health.

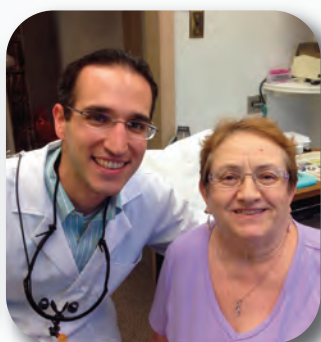
The program is a three-year pilot initiative focused on providing pro-bono oral care to the most economically vulnerable Holocaust survivors, as well as individuals of any faith who are survivors of Nazi persecution and meet the eligibility requirements of the program. In addition to financial need, the three critical factors in prioritizing patients for participation are: elimination of pain, restoration of function, and lack of dental coverage. A clear set of clinical guidelines directs the specific scope of care to be provided through this program.

Originally launched in January 2015 in nine cities—New York City, the New York/New Jersey metropolitan area, Boston, Chicago, Philadelphia, Detroit, Seattle, Montreal, and Toronto—the Alpha Omega-Henry Schein Cares Holocaust Survivors Oral Health Program expanded during 2015 to include three additional cities—Atlanta, Columbus, and Calgary. The scope of treatment is wide and comprehensive, ranging from emergency care to restorative, endodontic, periodontal, and prosthetic treatment—all expertly delivered at absolutely no charge to the patient.

Program Results: Year One—2015

To date, the results achieved through this program have been profound, both in terms of the impact upon the lives of survivors and the multi-faceted engagement of numerous stakeholders. In its first year of operation, the program expanded from nine to 12 cities and secured the participation of two dental schools. 145 economically vulnerable Holocaust survivors received necessary, comprehensive free dental care valued at more than \$500,000 at slightly more than \$100,000 operating expenditure.

Collaborating For Impact: An Exemplary Public-Private Partnership

The Alpha Omega-Henry Schein Cares Holocaust Survivors Oral Health Program draws its power from the strategic collaboration of multiple stakeholders, as illustrated by the graphic on pages 6 and 7. Propelled by the White House's call to action, Henry Schein partnered with Alpha Omega, whose membership of dentists are providing pro-bono care to patients. At the same time, Henry Schein leveraged its relationships with numerous organizations, including philanthropic partners, a dental laboratory, and a network of local referral agencies, in order to develop and run the program.

“Most critically, we issued a call for innovative public-private partnerships to fill in the gaps where survivors have unmet needs, and that’s where Henry Schein and Alpha Omega stepped up. Together you brought the resources of a major company and the skills of more than 200 dentists to provide services in major urban areas across the United States. In just 10 months, the partnership has provided 140 survivors with half a million in needed dental care, all free of charge, meeting our obligation. This obviously makes a difference. Individuals are referred to the program through members of the Association of Jewish Family & Children's Agencies and other identified local partner organizations. Once eligible patients are identified, Alpha Omega's participating members contribute their professional expertise and skills as dentists to provide care.

Henry Schein donates the dental supply kits used by participating dentists, while a dental laboratory donates crowns, dentures, and other appliances necessary for proper patient care. All dental work is completed under the clinical guidance of Dr. Allen Finkelstein, CEO of Bedford Health Care Solutions. Finally, a number of philanthropic partners generously contribute the essential financial resources needed to operate the program, managed and directed through Alpha Omega.

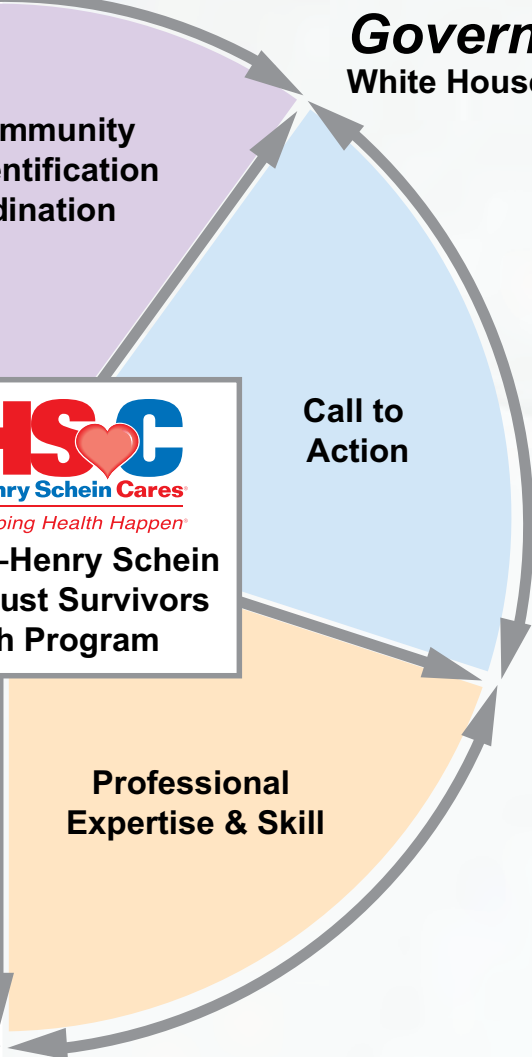

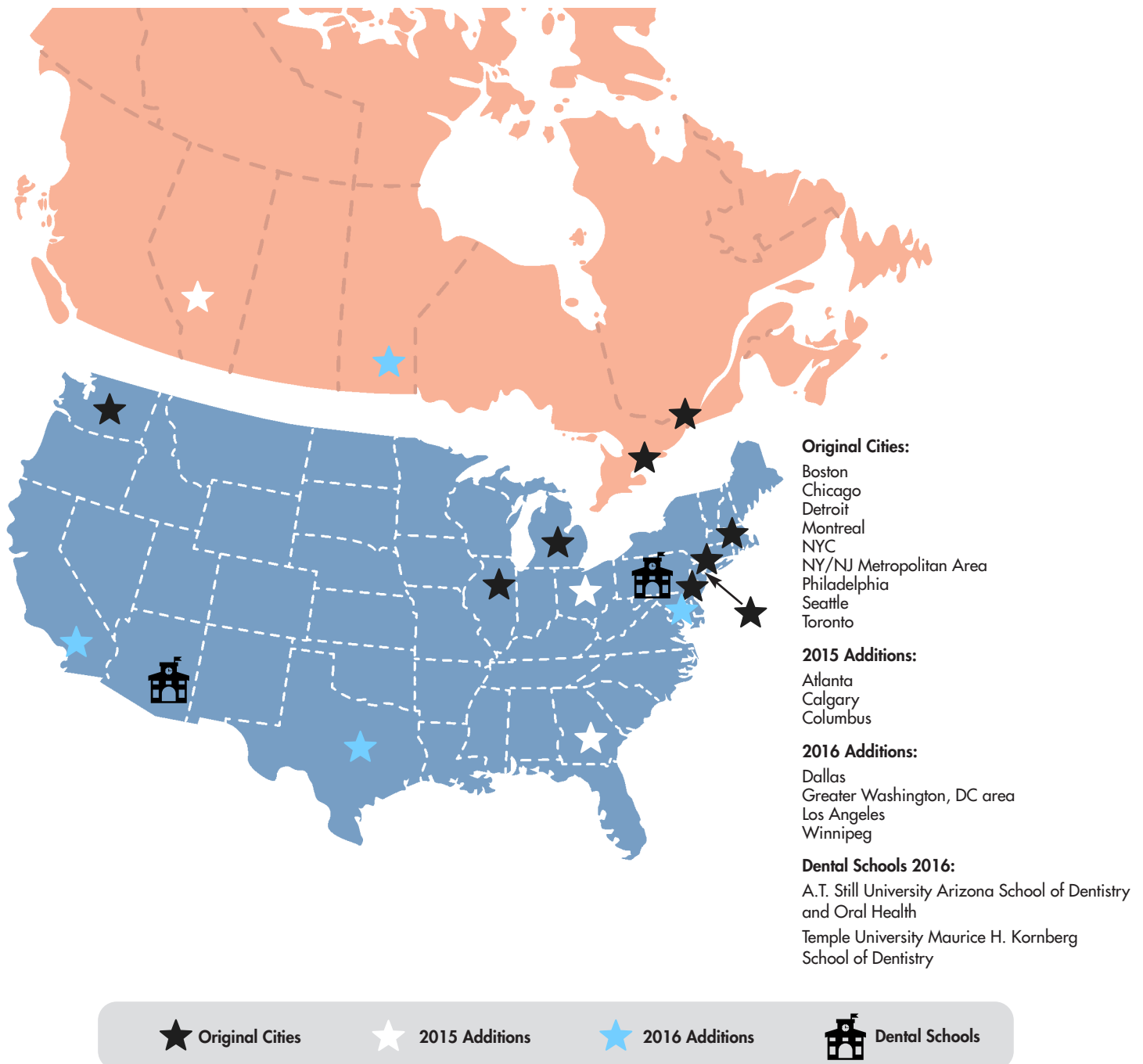

The program is on track for additional expansion and expects to provide an additional \$1 million in dental care in 2016. Four new cities will be added to the program's service area—Los Angeles, Dallas, Washington, DC, and Winnipeg—for a total of 16 cities in North America.

Discussions are also underway to expand the program to include two dental schools—Temple University Maurice H. Kornberg School of Dentistry and A.T. Still University Arizona School of Dentistry & Oral Health.
